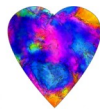
Message from the Advisory Council

It is hard to believe that in June we are embarking on Kairos Inside Weekend #8. Lori Watson, the weekend leader, has brought in 12 new volunteers. These are the blessings we are so grateful for as this community continues to grow. 24 participants will attend the weekend. We are blessed to have many churches contributing to this ministry throughout the year by their donations, prayer vigils, and baking cookies. We will be taking over 1200 dozen cookies in for the June weekend. One local church has baked over 300 dozen cookies to date. Another church will be baking 600 dozen cookies. Team members will also be baking “Kairos Cookies”. We are blessed to go into the prison the 2nd and 4th Saturday of each month. We average 14 volunteers and 30 participants.
